

**Documents required for the registration of change of company type of foreign investment companies**

1	Application form of registration for change(file) of foreign investment companies	Original
2	The authorization documents from the examine and approve department(both the approval and the duplicated authorization certificate)	Original
3*	Legal resolution or decision	Original
4	Amendment of company article-of-association or revised version signed by the legal representative	Original
5	The business license(both the original and duplicated), IC card (Electronic business license)	Original
6	Other related documents	

Note:

1. The application form must be filled out in black or blue-black ink with neat writing;
2. If the documents are not the original ones, copies signed or sealed by the applier are acceptable;
3. If the documents are not written in Chinese, a translated Chinese version sealed by the translation unit should be submitted;
4. Only one application form is needed for multiple application for change(file);
5. Regarding the item 3: according to the Company Law of the People's Republic of China, the law of the People's Republic of China on Chinese-Foreign Equity Joint Ventures, Laws and Regulations of the People's Republic of China Governing Foreign-Related Matters, Law of The People's Republic of China on Foreign-Capital Enterprises, and the regulations of the company, the resolution or decision should comply with the application;
6. If the change of the type of the company is accompanied by other change of the company, relevant change of registration should be applied at the same time and all the required documents should be submitted according to the format and requirements.
